CALCULATING THE GPA IN THE MAJOR

While a student must attain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) for all courses in order to graduate, the student must also attain a 2.0 cumulative GPA in the major as specified by the following criteria:

- 1. All courses taken in the major discipline count in calculating the GPA for that major (unless specifically excluded).
- 2. Courses required for the major but taken outside the major discipline are not counted in the computation of the major cumulative GPA.
- 3. Interdisciplinary majors, defined as such upon approval, count all courses specifically listed as meeting the requirements for the major.
- 4. As is the case for all University courses, if a course in the major is repeated, all grades earned for that course are included in the computation of the cumulative GPA for that major.
