PROCEDURE FOR RESIDENCY STATUS APPEAL

Any student who wishes to appeal the decision of residency status previously determined by the Office of the Registrar or Admissions office, may do so in writing to the Appeals Board for Residency Status. This board shall consist of representatives designated from the Provost, the Student and Educational Services, and the Administration and Finance divisions. The appeal will be reviewed by the board members in the order as listed. Only by unanimous agreement by the board members will the decision of the Office of the Registrar or Admissions Office be overruled. Upon request, the President or designee has the authority to waive any residency requirements if it is determined that the student is indeed a permanent resident and application of the criteria creates an unjust result.
